The purpose of this School Plan is to document the improvement work supported by the National Partnership Agreement on Literacy and Numeracy.

Funding provided by the Australian Government through the Smarter Schools National Partnerships is complemented by co-investment by the Western Australian education sectors and schools. Together, this funding is designed to build the capacity of Western Australian schools to contribute to the achievement of the following high level outcomes:

- (a) all children are engaged in and benefiting from schooling;
